CITY OF WINNIPEG CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: Resident/Business on Roblin Boulevard
RE: 2020-2021 Roblin Boulevard Pavement Renewals – Windmill Way to Dieppe Road

Please be advised that the second phase of the Roblin Boulevard Pavement Renewals Project is scheduled to begin on May 11, 2021.

Construction start: May 11, 2021
Duration: To be complete by September 2021
Traffic Implications: Roblin Boulevard in both directions from Community Row to Dieppe Road

We will be:

- Removing existing asphalt and patching the existing concrete pavement where required
- Renewing curbs and sidewalks
- Replacing traffic signals and repairing sewers as required
- Resurfacing the road with a thick layer of new asphalt
- Replacing sod landscaping where required

This work will improve drainage and rideability and extend the life of the roadway.

During construction, traffic will be restricted to one lane in each direction. Local access will be permitted via the closed lanes to ensure access to residences and businesses is maintained. Garbage and recycling pickup will remain unchanged. Pedestrian access to residences and businesses will also be maintained. Transit service will be maintained, however some stops may be temporarily relocated or closed for short periods of time.

Simultaneous to the scheduled 2021 work, we will also complete warranty items from Phase 1 (Roblin from Stack Street/Windmill Way to Community Row).
