About the Project

Riverbank Stabilization

Taché Avenue is a regional street that forms a portion of the City's primary diking system to defend against flooding along the Red River. The section of Taché Avenue between the Esplanads Reit pedestrain bridge (Provencher Boulevard) to Despirs Street a ladorg the custable than of the east bank of the Red River and has a history of merebank instabilies. Multiple stabilization and enoison protection projects have been understaten over the years. Ballongs none positions remain unprotected. A working group of key stakeholders have been meeting for several years to advance the vision of a walking/cycling loop linking Winnipeg's culturally important and historically significant destinations and organizations on both The Forks and \$1. Bonface a does of the Red River. These sites include. The Forks National Historic Site Net Canadian Nuseum for Human Rights. Esplanade Riel Bridge. Norwood Bridge, the Taché Docks, the \$1. Bonface Museum, the \$1. Bonface Cathedrial, and the \$2. Bonface Hospital. Various projects sponsors are developing portions of the loop. The role of the working group is to ensure coordination and collaboration between the various stakeholders in linking destinations, interpreting ports of interest, and creating an enjoyated and memorable used repetience.

The belvedere is a 100 metre long wallway suspended in the river forest canopy off the Taché Promenade. It was envisioned to provide a unique perspective on the river landscape, and capture one of the most spectacular views in Winnipeg, framing the Canadian Nusure for Human Rights, Esplanade Riel, The Forks, and the downtrown skyline. It will be an improvement to the foregrounds of the St. Boniface Museum and cathedral, and is a key addition to the proposed St. Boniface/Forks Loop, which will link destinations on both sides of the river becoming a tourist attraction in itself.

Planning and Design is Now Underway

The design has now progressed through detailed design. The plan is to perform the riverbank stabilization work over the winter of 2017-2018, and construct the promenade and pedestrian belvedere features in 2018.


