

2022 DOWNTOWN PAVEMENT RENEWAL



2021

DONALD STREET

between St. Mary Ave & Broadway:

Pavement reconstruction from St. Mary Avenue to Broadway consisted of removing and replacing the existing pavement, and constructing new concrete sidewalks including streetscaping.

DONALD STREET

between Broadway & Gertrude Ave:

Pavement rehabilitation from Broadway to Gertrude Avenue is consisted of repairing the existing pavement, placing an asphalt overlay and constructing new concrete sidewalks including streetscaping.

(Note: Did not include Midtown Bridge.)

HARGRAVE STREET

between York Ave & Broadway:

Pavement reconstruction from York Avenue to Broadway consisted of removing and replacing the existing pavement, and constructing new concrete sidewalks including streetscaping.



APRIL-AUGUST

SMITH STREET

between Midtown Bridge and Graham Avenue:

Pavement Rehabilitation will consist of repairing the existing pavement, placing an asphalt overlay, new concrete sidewalks and a new signalized pedestrian crossing on Smith Street at Navy Way. The project will also include geometric improvements which will improve vehicular/ pedestrian safety.

SMITH STREET

between Graham Avenue and Portage Avenue:

Pavement Reconstruction will consist of removal and replacement of the existing pavement, new curb bump-outs, and construction of new concrete sidewalks.



JUNE-OCTOBER

SMITH STREET

between Portage Avenue and Ellice Avenue:

Pavement Reconstruction will consist of removal and replacement of the existing pavement, new curb bump-outs, and construction of new concrete sidewalks.



TRANSIT:

Transit Service is to be maintained throughout construction, however temporary bus stop relocations or closures may be required at various times. Access to businesses will be maintained as much as possible with short term, temporary adjustments as required. Any disruption to access will be discussed with the applicable business/resident, prior to the disruption.
