Adult Nuisance Mosquito Fogging Program suspended

Winnipeg, MB – The City’s Insect Control Branch is suspending its adult nuisance mosquito fogging program due to low overnight temperatures. The city wide average adult mosquito trap count for today, June 16, 2015, was 15. All quadrants are substantially below 100.

When overnight temperatures are cool, adult mosquito activity is depressed. Fogging is most effective when the mosquitoes are actively flying and they come in direct contact with the droplets of Malathion in the air.

Adulticiding Factor Analysis (AFA) Remains High

All factors of the AFA, including trap counts will continue to be monitored on a daily basis. The AFA remains at high. Fogging will resume when trap counts are in the range of 100 in one or more quadrants of the city.

A Public Service Announcement will be issued eight hours prior to resuming the Adult Nuisance Mosquito Fogging Program.

The Insect Control Branch’s extensive larviciding and residual treatment programs will continue.

Buffer zones

Property owners not wanting insecticides applied on or adjacent to their principal residence may register as “Anti-Pesticide Registrants” (APR) for the adult nuisance mosquito control program. Those who wish to register must provide identification that ties the registrant to the address being registered for a buffer zone. A photocopy or scanned document such as a driver’s licence or a utility bill will suffice as acceptable identification proving primary residence. Remember – a 72-hour turnaround time is required.

Please note that since identification is required, registrations cannot be processed over the phone.

Phone and email notification

The Insect Control Branch offers an automated telephone and email notification system. Residents who register for this service will receive daily phone or email notifications during all fogging for adult mosquito control.
