

Locations

1. Little Mountain Park - located on Klimpke Rd, north of Inkster Blvd.
2. Kilcona Park - located at Lagimodiere Blvd. & McIvor Ave.
3. King's Park - located on King's Dr. at Kilkenny Dr.
4. Maple Grove Park - located at St. Mary's Rd. at the Perimeter Hwy. - multi-use park with football, rugby, organized disk sports and boat launching facilities.
5. St. Boniface Industrial Park - located at Mazenod Rd. and Camiel Sys St.
6. Bourkevale Park - Adjacent to the Active Transportation Corridor at Ferry Rd. south of Portage Ave.
7. Westview Park - entire park is an off-leash area, located at Saskatchewan Ave & Midland, can also enter at Empress St. and Wellington Ave.
8. Sturgeon Rd. & Silver Ave. - this open space has great trails for your dog's enjoyment.
9. Woodsworth Park - parking is located near maintenance building off of Hekla Ave.
10. Charleswood Parkway - between Oakdale Dr. and Haney.
11. Downtown Dog Park - located in Bonnycastle Park, Assiniboine Ave. & Garry St.



Code of Ethics

For all dog owners
in an off-leash dog park:

- Stoop and Scoop – use plastic bags to pickup after your dog
- Train your dog – to respond to commands
- Respect other users of the park – walkers, joggers, cyclists, skiers and other dog owners have a right to enjoy the park
- Proper licensing is required – ensure your pet is properly licensed



Rules of Use for Off-leash Dog Parks

- All dogs must wear a valid license
- Dog owners must be present and within view of their dogs at all times
- Aggressive dogs are not allowed in off-leash areas
- Dog owners must have a leash in hand at all times
- Dogs must be under voice command in off-leash areas
- Female dogs in heat are not allowed in off-leash areas
- All feces must be picked up by the dog owner and removed or deposited in waste receptacles
- All sites are open from sunrise to sunset or as posted at the site
- Holes dug by dogs must be filled by the dog owner to prevent others from being injured
