Dear Sir / Madam:

We wish to advise you that completion of the above mentioned renewal project will be partially deferred to the 2018 construction season. Construction is expected to restart the week of May 15<sup>th</sup> and continue for approximately 6 weeks. Over the winter, traffic routing will be adjusted to accommodate the incomplete portions of work. Please see the sketch on the back of this letter for further detail.

Between Berry Street and Century Street, work is near completion and will operate as intended with:

- One travel lane westbound and eastbound
- One bike lane westbound and eastbound
- One parking lane westbound

Between Ferry Road and Berry Street, the roadway operation will be modified to accommodate any incomplete work and include temporary asphalt ramps at intersections.

- Two travel lanes westbound (please note this is temporary condition and will become one travel lane westbound when the project is complete in 2018)
- One travel lane eastbound
- One parking lane westbound
- One parking lane eastbound (also a temporary condition)

We recognize that this project will cause you some inconvenience and we apologize for the delays. We will work as quickly as possible to complete the project in Spring 2018.
