**Reference: Keewatin Street Bike Path**

Funding was approved by Winnipeg City Council in the 2017 Pedestrian and Cycling Program of the Capital Budget for the installation of a concrete sidewalk and asphalt bike path in the west boulevard of Keewatin Street from Inkster Boulevard to Burrows Avenue. Construction of this project is anticipated to begin in August 2017 and run to October 2017. The west sidewalk will be closed for this duration, but the east sidewalk will remain open for pedestrian access.

Work will take place to widen the boulevard as required and shift the alignment of Keewatin Street to allow for the full width construction of the bike path. During peak hours, two lanes of southbound traffic will be maintained on Keewatin Street, but there will be temporary lane closures in off-peak hours to perform the work.

Should your approach require work, you will be notified directly by Stantec and we will arrange a time to minimize disruptions of the approach for your benefit. Emergency access will always be maintained through the construction zone.
