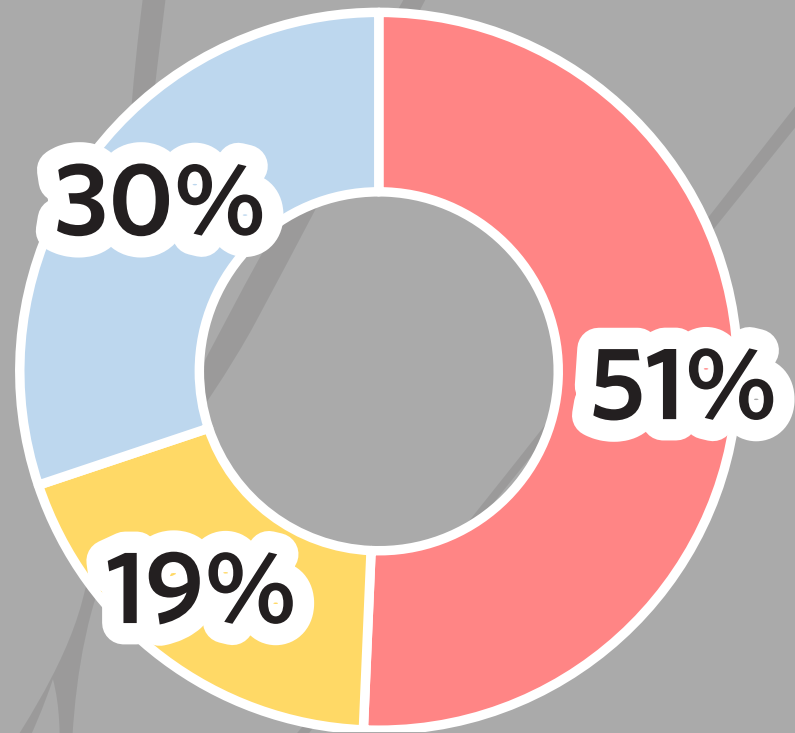

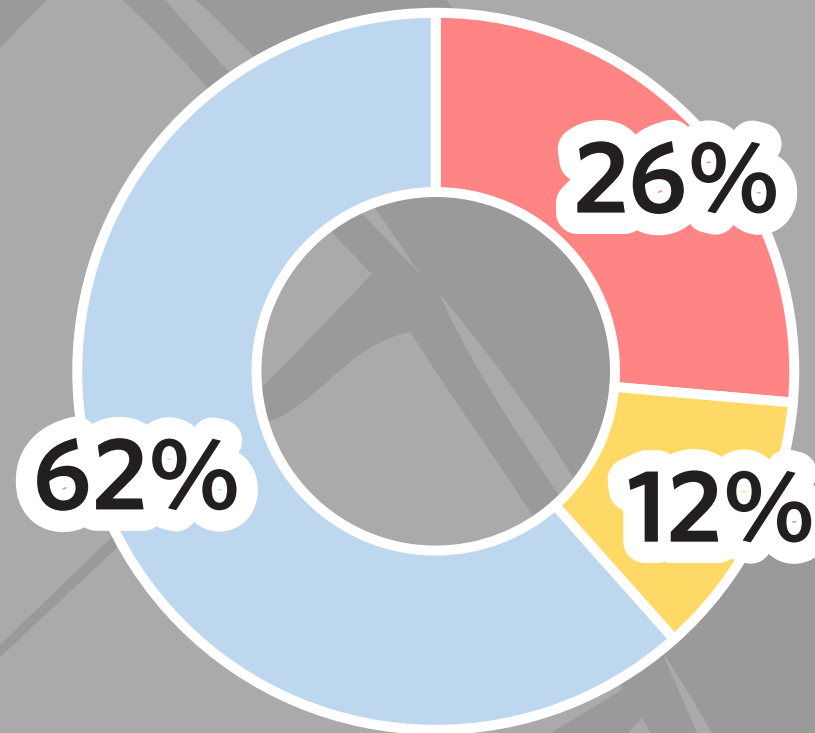

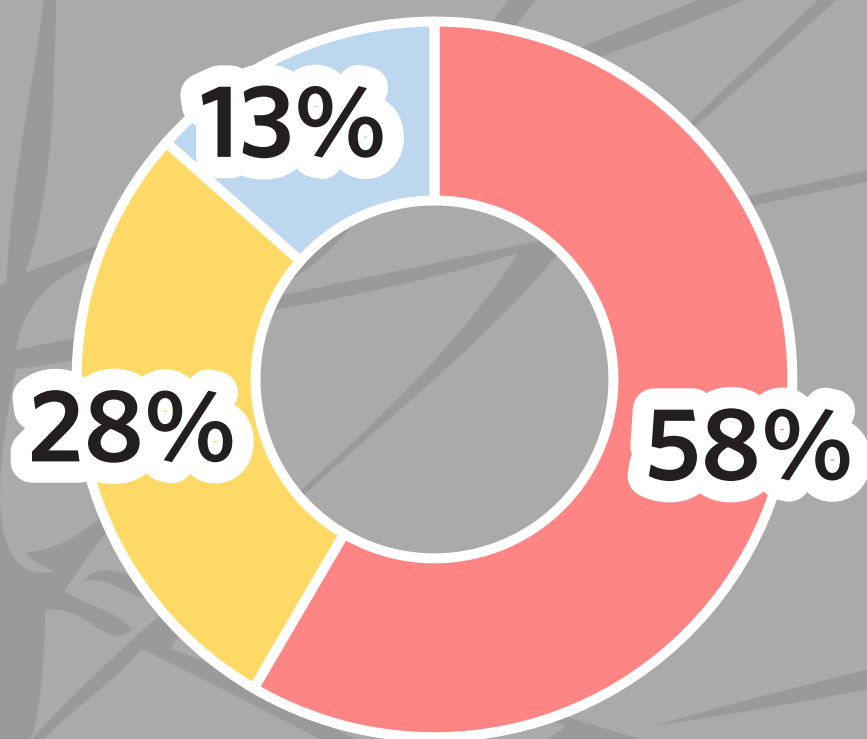

Beliveau Rd. / Beaverhill Blvd.



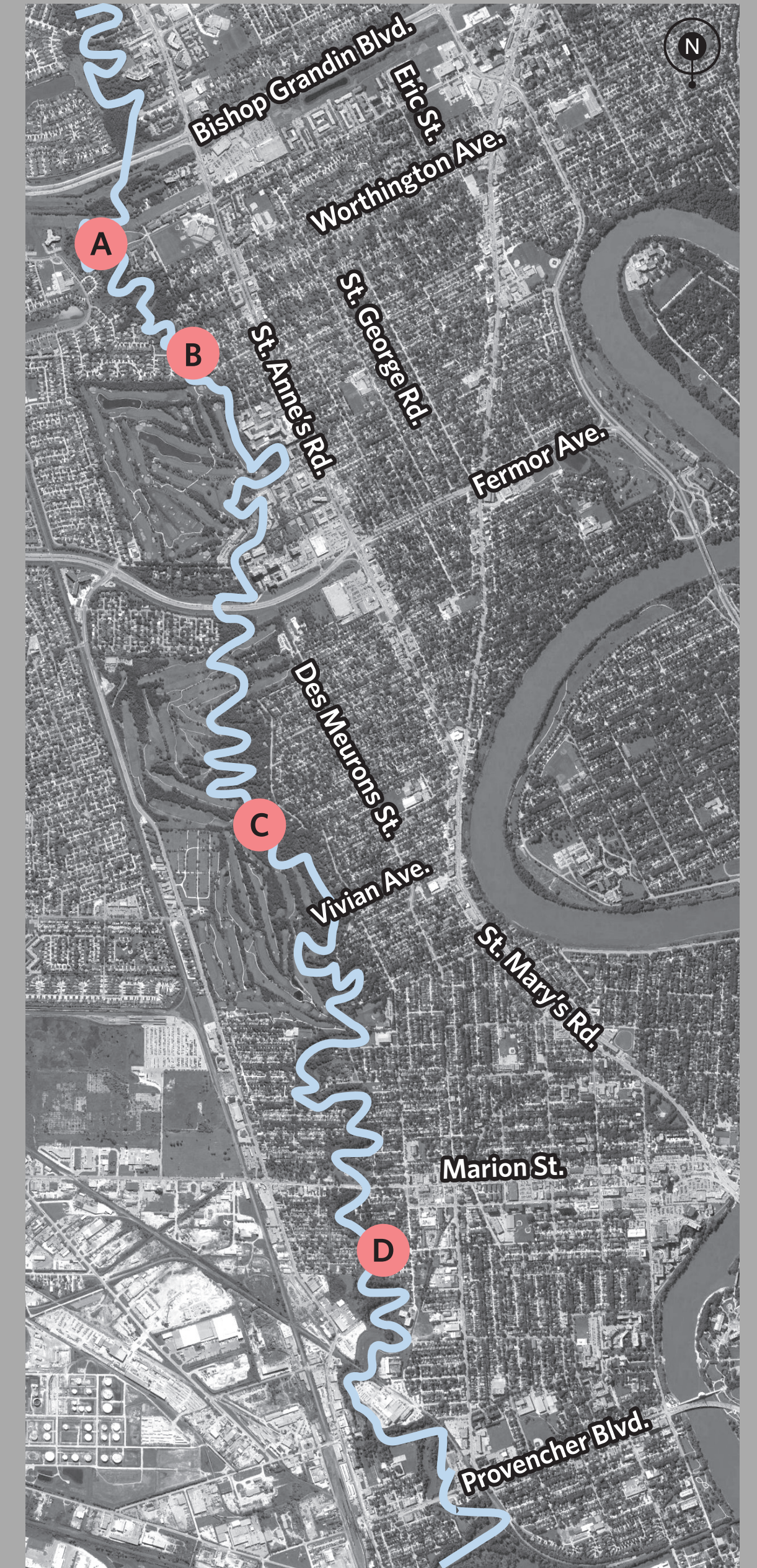
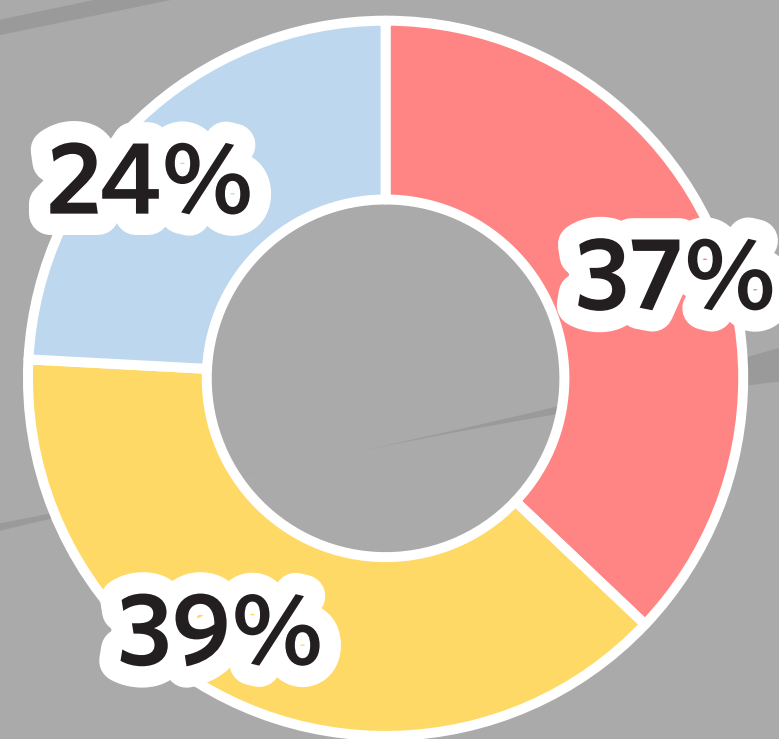

WHAT WE HEARD



It is important to protect the wildlife and maintain the beauty of the Seine River.



A new crossing location should provide access to the Seine River for recreational purposes.



A new Seine River crossing should improve connections to pedestrian and cycling infrastructure and community destinations.



Locating a new Seine River crossing away from residential homes is preferred.



The location of a new Seine River crossing should be midway between existing river crossings.



ONLINE SURVEY

Of 237 respondents, 75% live near the Seine River. Respondents indicated that private vehicle, walking and cycling are the main modes of transportation.
