SUBJECT: NO MOVEMENT OF BUS TRANSIT IN RELATION TO WOLSELEY TO DOWNTOWN WALK BIKE PROJECT

In spring 2019, the City of Winnipeg provided two options to the public for improving active transportation in the Wolseley to Downtown area. Option 1 of the West Segment (Raglan Road to Furby Street) included shifting a bus transit route from Evanson Street to Home Street between Westminster Avenue and Wolseley Avenue to allow for proposed traffic calming measures throughout the area.

Following the second phase of public engagement, routes and treatments were evaluated based on:

- public feedback (through in-person and online engagement);
- detailed discussions with civic departments; and,
- further technical assessment.

As a result of this evaluation, the proposed movement of bus transit to Home Street was not selected for further investigation within the scope of the current project.

The project team is currently refining pedestrian and cycling improvements for the Wolseley to Downtown Walk Bike Project. Designs will be shared with the community in fall 2019 and we anticipate submitting recommended designs to City Council for its consideration in late 2019.
