## DECLARATION OF EXTENDED SNOW ROUTE PARKING BAN

WHEREAS The Winter Parking Ban By-law No. 76/2011 provides as follows:

## Extended Snow Route Parking Bans

**5(1)** When he or she considers it necessary for effective snow clearing operations, the Director is authorized, in compliance with subsection 8(2), to declare an Extended Snow Route Parking Ban which prohibits stopping, standing or parking vehicles on snow routes between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m. on the dates specified in the declaration.

**5(2)** No person may stop, stand or park a vehicle, and the owner of a vehicle must not permit it to be stopped, stood or parked, in contravention of an Extended Snow Route Parking Ban declared pursuant to subsection (1).

**AND WHEREAS** I have determined that an Extended Snow Route Parking Ban is necessary for effective snow clearing operations.

**NOW THEREFORE** I hereby declare an Extended Snow Route Parking Ban to be effective between the following dates and times:

Start date and time: Tuesday, December 28 at 12 a.m.

End date and time: Wednesday, December 29, 2021 at 1:59 a.m.
