DECLARATION OF RESIDENTIAL PARKING BAN

WHEREAS The Winter Parking Ban By-law No. 76/2011 provides as follows:

Residential Parking Bans

6(1) For the purposes of this By-law, in order to assist in the efficient and effective snow clearing operations, the Director must, in compliance with subsection 8(1), assign every street or portion of a street in the City to a snow clearing zone and may reassign previously-assigned streets or portions of streets to different zones.

6(2) When he or she considers it necessary for effective snow clearing operations, the Director is authorized, in compliance with subsection 8(2), to declare a Residential Parking Ban which prohibits stopping, standing or parking a vehicle in one or more of the snow clearing zones at a time or times and on a date or dates specified in the declaration.

6(3) No person may stop, stand or park a vehicle, and the owner of a vehicle must not permit it to be stopped, stood or parked, in contravention of a Residential Parking Ban declared pursuant to subsection (2).

AND WHEREAS I have determined that a Residential Parking Ban is necessary for effective snow clearing operations on the dates set out below.

NOW THEREFORE I HEREBY DECLARE a Residential Parking Ban to be effective on the following schedule of dates and times with respect to zones established by previous declarations and published on the City of Winnipeg website:

Thursday, December 30, 2021 from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. on Friday, December 31, 2021 D, I, O, S, U, V

Friday, December 31, 2021 from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Friday, December 31, 2021 E, G, J, L, P, R

Friday, December 31, 2021 from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. on Saturday, January 1, 2022 B, F, H, K, M, N, Q, T

Saturday, January 1, 2022 from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Saturday, January 1, 2022 A

Saturday, January 1, 2022 from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. on Sunday, January 2, 2022 C
