AND WHEREAS members of the public service in the Winnipeg Parking Authority, have indicated that 1 hour parking restrictions are little enforced due to constraints on resources;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Standing Policy Committee on Infrastructure Renewal and Public Works direct the Winnipeg Public Service to change any remaining one-hour time limited parking to two-hour time limited parking everywhere in the Norwood Grove BIZ area, including especially Taché Avenue, the length of Marion Street, and on Kenny Street, where applicable.
