(St. Vital Ward)**

STANDING COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:

The Standing Policy Committee on Infrastructure Renewal and Public Works concurred in the recommendation of the Riel Community Committee and directed the Winnipeg Public Service to conduct a traffic study on Edward Turner Drive between Sage Creek Boulevard and Des Hivernants Boulevard to determine possible traffic calming measures, including whether a three way stop sign is warranted at Edward Turner Drive and Wild Iris Walk, and report back to the Standing Committee within 180 days.
