STANDING COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:

The Standing Policy Committee on Infrastructure Renewal and Public Works concurred in the recommendation of the City Centre Community Committee, as amended, and directed the Winnipeg Public Service to conduct a traffic study to determine if a crosswalk, pedestrian corridor, or other pedestrian crossing treatment at Stradbrook Avenue and Wellington Crescent is warranted, and report back within 180 days.

COMMUNITY COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:

On September 4, 2020, the City Centre Community Committee passed the following motion:

WHEREAS the area in and around Wellington Crescent is one of Winnipeg’s most historic and attractive neighbourhoods;

AND WHEREAS pedestrian activity should be encouraged in all areas of the City to make transportation within Winnipeg healthier and more sustainable;

AND WHEREAS safe locations to cross streets such as Wellington Crescent encourage the use of walking as a travel mode;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Standing Policy Committee on Infrastructure Renewal and Public Works be requested to direct the Winnipeg Public Service to conduct a traffic study to determine if a crosswalk, pedestrian corridor, or other pedestrian crossing treatment at Stradbroke Avenue and Wellington Crescent is warranted, and report back within 120 days.
