

## Seine Riverbank Stabilization at the Branch 1 Aqueduct

This project will stabilize the east bank of the Seine River, near the corner of Notre Dame Street and Maisonneuve Street. Stabilizing the bank is necessary to keep the Branch 1 Aqueduct safe and ensure a continued supply of water to Winnipeg residents.

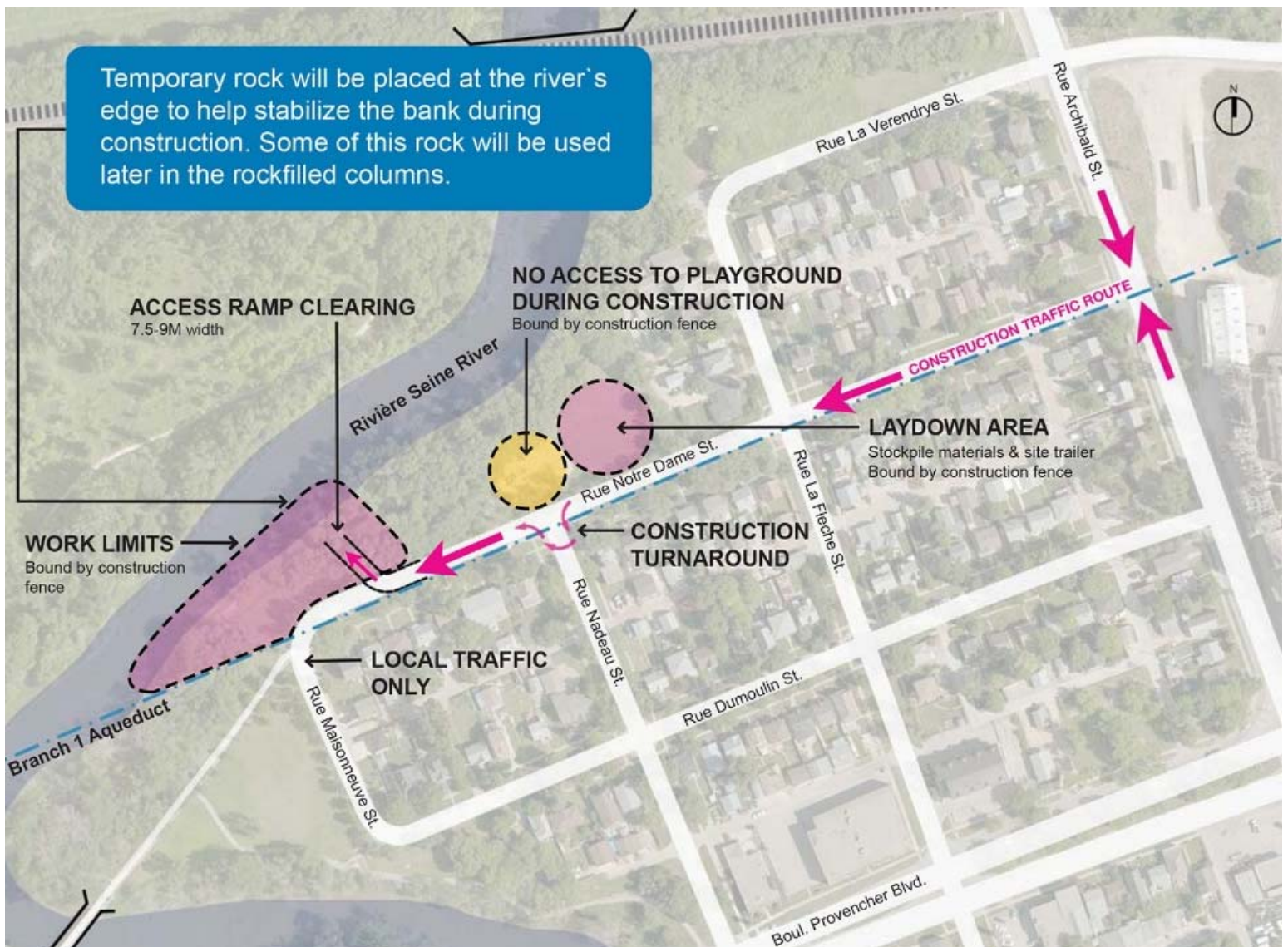
Construction on this project is anticipated to begin within the first two weeks of January 2018, with January 2 as the first potential start date. The first activities that you will see are the site preparation and installation of safety fencing. Other construction activities will include:

- Delivery and placement of rockfill rip rap and installation of rockfill columns
- Revegetation and naturalization of the site

Notre Dame Street and Maisonneuve Street will remain open for local traffic only. Pedestrian and cycling access will also be maintained, however, normal routes may be altered. During the construction period, the riverbank and playground area will be closed. For your safety, please respect warning signs and restrictions. Stabilization works are anticipated to be completed by June 2018. As part of this project, roadworks will take place in summer 2018. A separate construction notice will be issued at that time.

The City of Winnipeg realizes that the construction work may be disruptive and we will endeavor to complete the work as quickly and efficiently as possible. We thank you for your patience.
