

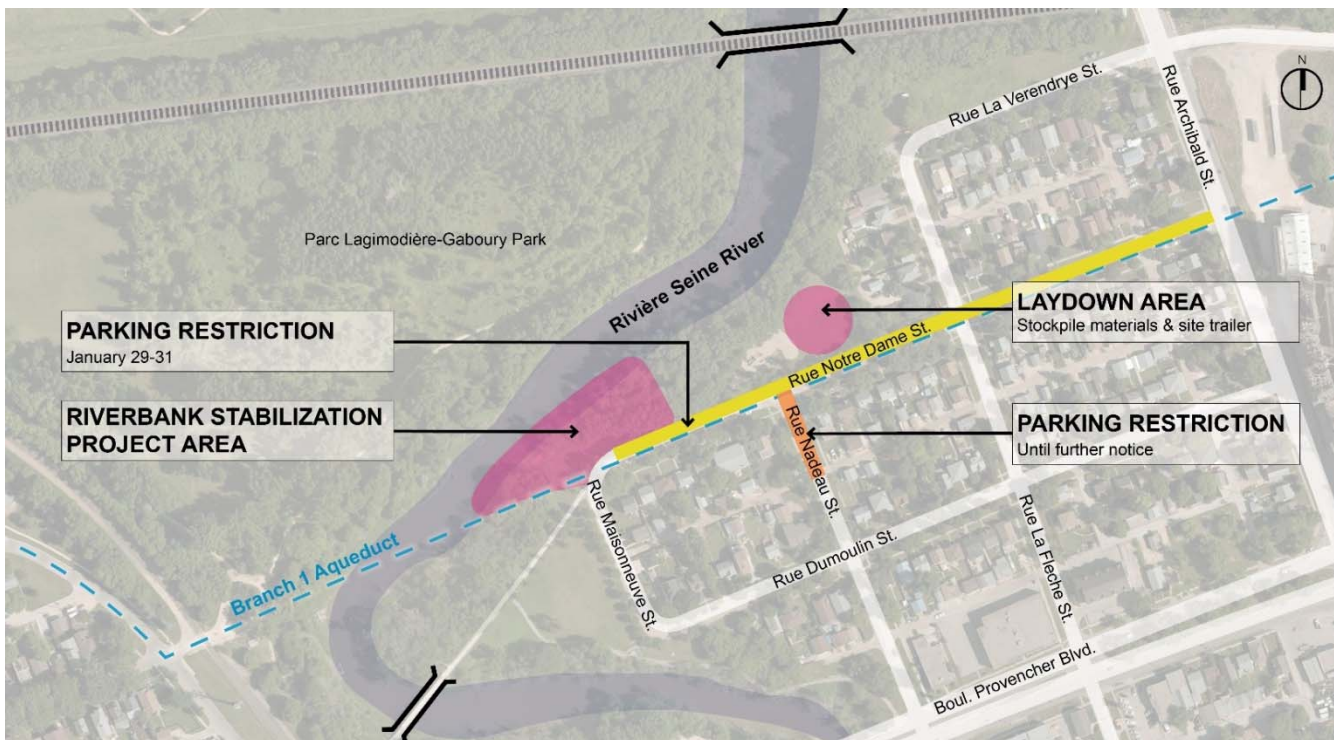
### Seine Riverbank Stabilization at the Branch 1 Aqueduct

Work is underway to stabilize the east bank of the Seine River, near the corner of Notre Dame Street and Maisonneuve Street, in North St. Boniface. Stabilizing the bank is necessary to keep the Branch 1 Aqueduct safe and ensure a continued supply of water to Winnipeg residents. Stabilization works are expected to be completed by June 2018.

### Parking Restrictions

- The contractor will be bringing two large pieces of construction equipment to the site on January 30 and 31, beginning at 5:30 a.m. The equipment is a crane and a drill rig, which require special permits, a police escort and parking restrictions. The parking restrictions will be in effect on Notre Dame Street between Archibald Street and Maisonneuve Street beginning at 10 p.m. on Monday, January 29 until 8 p.m. on Wednesday, January 31, 2018.
- To ensure safety during construction activities, street parking will also now be restricted on Nadeau Street between Notre Dame Street and the first back lane. This restriction is from 7 a.m. until 7 p.m., Monday to Saturday, effective immediately until further notice.

Signs will be installed to communicate these restrictions. The City of Winnipeg realizes that this work may be disruptive and we thank you for your patience.
