

### Seine Riverbank Stabilization at the Branch 1 Aqueduct – Roadwork Summer 2018

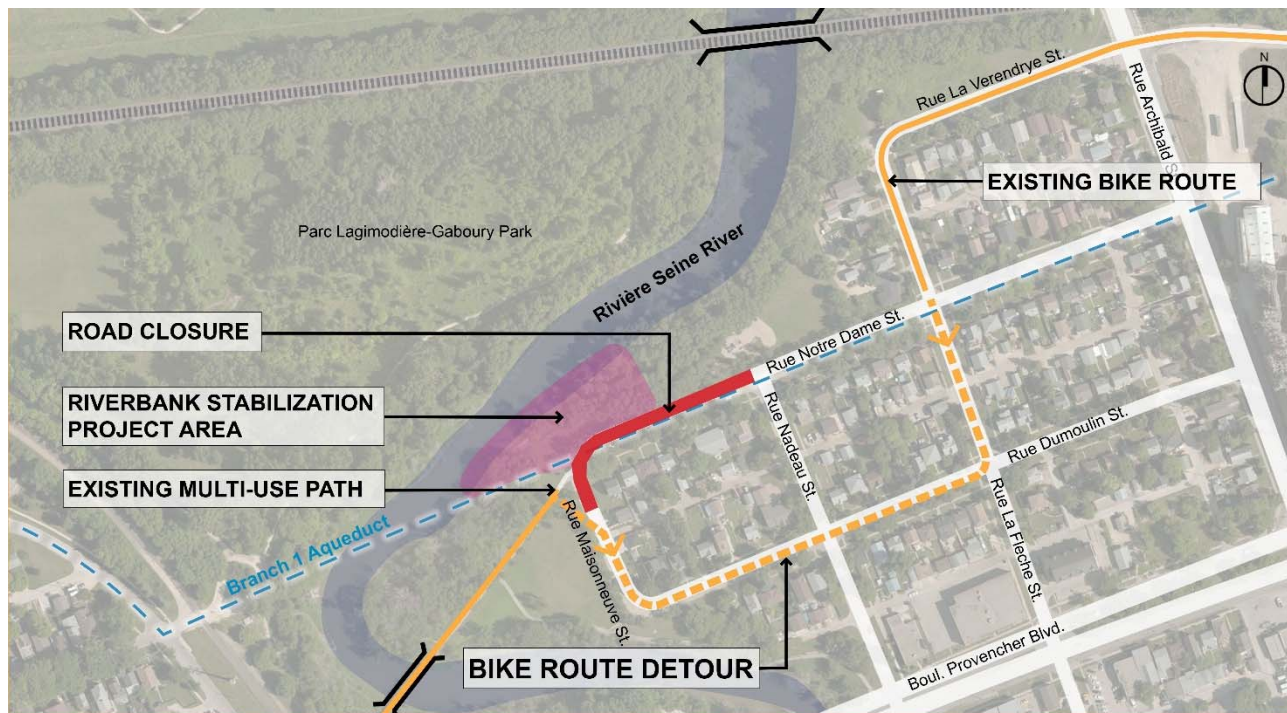
The Seine riverbank stabilization portion of work near the corner of Notre Dame Street and Maisonneuve Street is now complete. Stabilizing the bank was necessary to keep the Branch 1 Aqueduct safe and ensure a continued supply of water to Winnipeg residents. Revegetation of the site is now underway. Starting in the coming weeks, roads will be re-graded to accommodate the surface water in the area. The roadworks and the first phase of revegetation are expected to be completed by June 30, 2018.

#### Road Closure, Parking Restrictions and Bike Detour

Notre Dame Street will be closed between Maisonneuve Street and Nadeau Street, and Maisonneuve Street will be closed between Notre Dame Street and the first back lane. No parking will be permitted until further notice. Signs will be installed to communicate this closure.

To ensure safety for cyclists, a detour is now in place. Cyclists are encouraged to use Dumoulin Street between Maisonneuve Street and La Fleche Street. This detour is in effect until further notice.

The City of Winnipeg realizes that the construction work may be disruptive and we will complete the work as quickly and efficiently as possible. We thank you for your patience.
