Sandbag dike no longer required at your residence

You can now take down your sandbag dike. We recommend that you do this as soon as possible to reduce the potential of riverbank failure. It is the property owner's responsibility to remove and dispose of the sandbags.

The risk of river flooding is now significantly reduced. The Red River water level has dropped below 18 feet and will continue to drop over the next few weeks.

Earlier in our flood fighting efforts we placed sandbags over select manholes. These sandbags help prevent basement flooding by keeping rainwater out of the wastewater sewer. We will remove these sandbags once the river level has dropped a few more feet.
