Landscaping and Long-term Site Planning

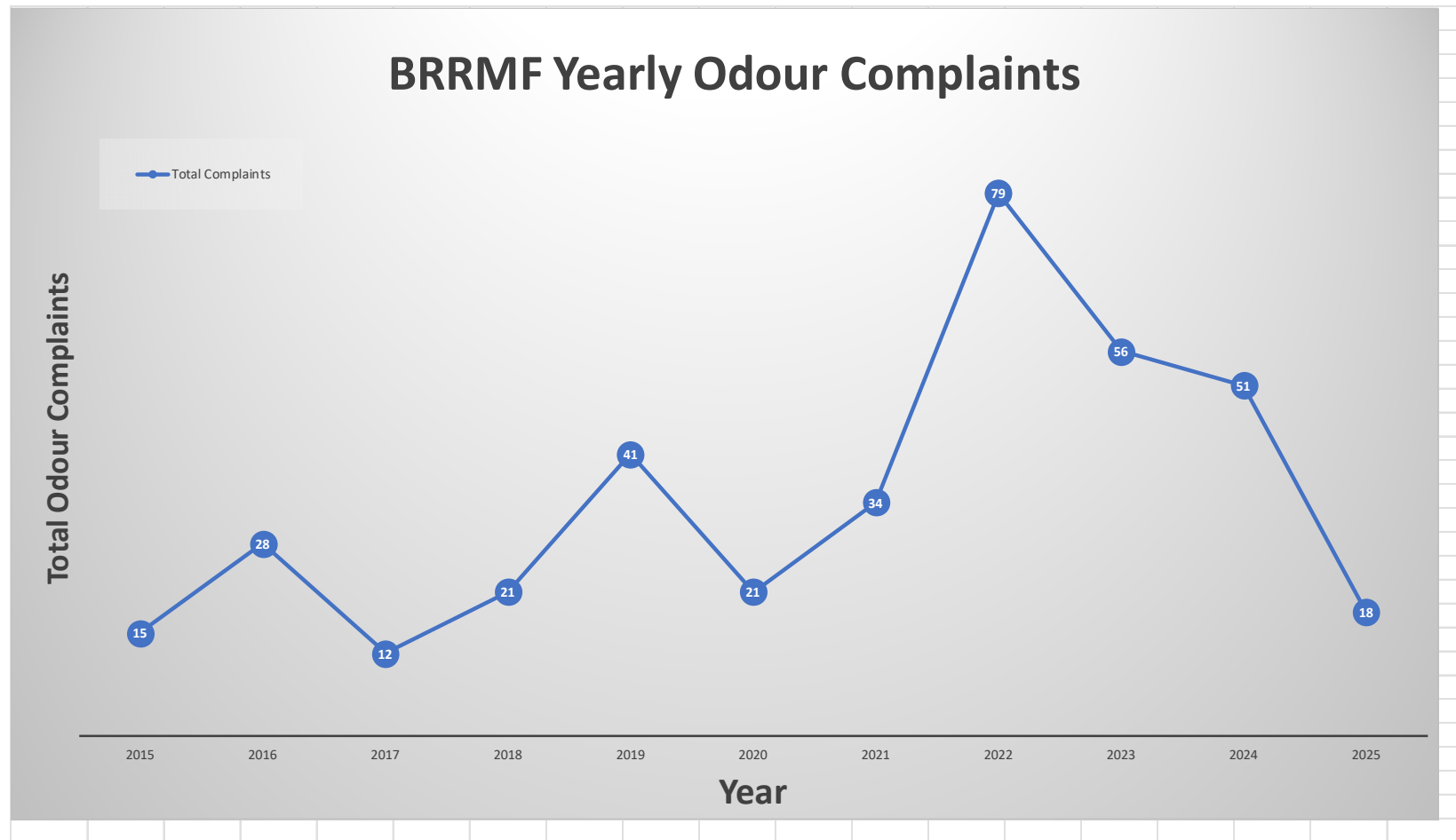
- Shelter belt planting of hybrid popular and willows completed June 2024. Seem to be doing well.
- Look at planting options on Lime Mud berm

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Odour, Noise and Nuisance Management

- Received 17 odour complaints since our last meeting (next slide odour complaint trend graph).
- Litter control continues
 - Using wind fencing
 - New Directions and Siloam Mission helping with litter picking onsite
 - Trying some secondary fencing around the North side of Compost Facility

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Site Improvements, Seasonal & Project Activity

- 2025 curbside yard waste collection end Oct 31st for week A, Nov 7th for week B
- Received 303 mm this year, fall conditions have been challenging when most of the rain came
- We switched to winter hours of operation on Nov 3rd, 2025
- Higher number of vectors (seagulls) this year

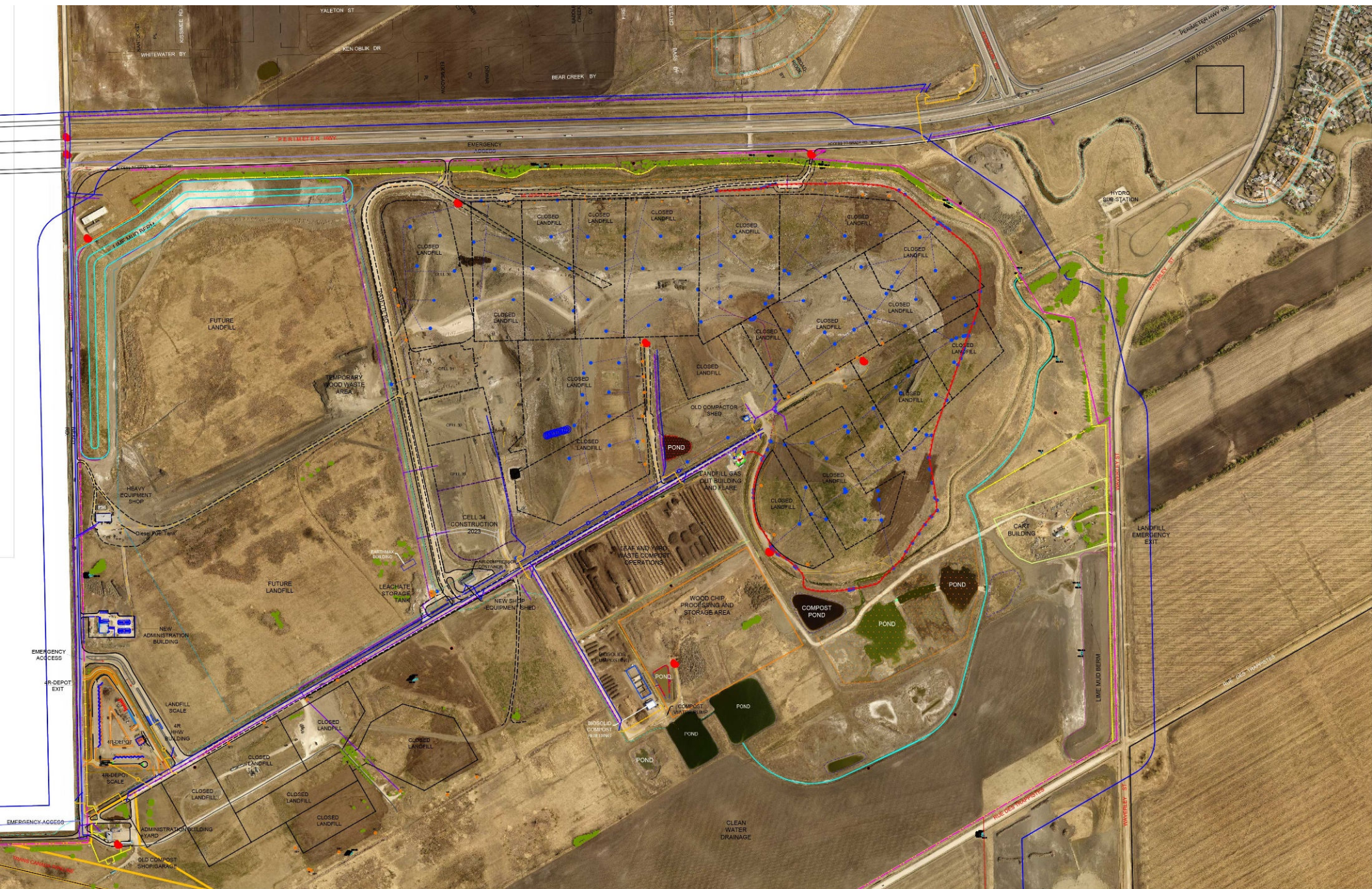

- Cell 35 construction began May of this year with the new cell opening late fall of 2025. Going to be using Tire derived aggregate for some of the drainage blanket.
- New survey grade drone and software.
- Public Awareness Program for lithium ion batteries.
- Pilot on real time methane monitoring sensors on Brady's North Slope. Looking at adding other detectors next year.
- RFP to build a compost facility for the city-wide green cart program will be going out in January 2026 along with a campaign to inform residents. It will be built on city-owned land south of the BRRMF. Construction will begin in mid to late 2027 at the earliest.
