Updates

- Start excavation in November
- Trucking routes have been mapped
- 225 trucks per day
- Crews will work 24 hours during Phase 1
- Phase 1 is expected to be completed in December (weather permitting)
- Phase 2 is expected to commence in spring (weather permitting)

Lime Mud Berm Construction

Summary of Feedback

- Conflict with the proposed by-pass through Waverley
 - The Province confirmed there will be no conflict
- Concerns with truck routes
 - Public Works reviewed and confirmed the truck routes will not affect traffic significantly
