Re: North End Water Pollution Control Centre – Environment Act Licence No. 2684 RRR - Interim Phosphorous Reduction Plan - Quarterly Progress Report Response

Thank you for the April 14, 2022, quarterly progress report regarding the interim phosphorus reduction plan implementation at the North End Water Pollution Control Centre (NEWPCC) during the months of January, February, and March 2022.

For consistency and ease of comparison, in future reports, replace the two columns (% completed in February and March) by one column indicating the percent (%) completed as you reported in the previous quarterly report.

The City of Winnipeg must continue to submit quarterly progress reports with details including correct information such as start date, targeted completion date, and current status for each activity and milestone the city has identified.
