

# Important notice about your water

## Notice of upcoming water main flushing

We will be flushing the water main on your street within the next four days (weekends included). This work should take less than one hour. Flushing crews work from 8 a.m. to as late as 11 p.m.

### Before the flushing

If you will need water while we are flushing, fill containers with water for drinking and cooking.

### After the flushing

- If the water isn't clear, turn off the tap, wait 30 minutes and try again. Water is sometimes discoloured after water main flushing, but this should not last long.
- If your water is still discoloured after two to three hours, call 311 or email [311@winnipeg.ca](mailto:311@winnipeg.ca)

**Do not use discoloured water for any purposes that require clean water (e.g., preparing food and beverages, laundry).**

This recommendation is because discoloured water does not taste, smell or look pleasant, and it can stain clothes. Health officials do not believe that drinking discoloured water would pose a health risk.
