We have completed a comprehensive review of our existing Water Works By-law and drafted a new Water By-law. We are now seeking feedback from the public before we send it to City Council for consideration.

The existing City of Winnipeg Water Works By-law No. 504/73, passed by City Council on November 7, 1973, required a thorough review and update.

Our goal is a new and improved by-law that will protect public health by ensuring that we have strong, enforceable measures in place to protect the City's waterworks system and safeguard the high quality of our drinking water.
